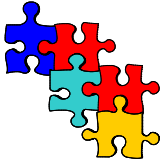

Bailey's Team for Autism is pleased to announce the launch of our 2025 funding cycle, which will begin August 1, 2024. Please note that we are accepting proposals thru October 1, 2024. Our Board of Directors will review proposals in January and February and grantees will be notified of our decisions no later than March 1, 2025.

Bailey's Team has been raising funds and providing grants to non-profit organizations since 2001 and to date we have funded over \$1.3 million in support of individuals with autism spectrum disorders and their families. Our priority areas for funding include education and training, programming & recreation, technology and equipment, family support, and research. Our intention is to fund projects that provide opportunities and improve the lives of all ages of individuals on the autism spectrum. In addition, we fund projects that aid those who support individuals with autism including parents and other family members, educators, and service providers. Our average grants funded in recent years have been between \$5,000 and \$10,000. *Please note that we do not provide direct financial assistance to families or individuals.*

Priority will be given to detailed submissions demonstrating impact and the ability to measure results. Expected outcomes should be clearly identified, and a detailed budget and plan for execution should also be included. Bailey's Team looks to fund projects that can begin implementation as a result of funding – whether we are the sole source or part of a larger collaborative funding effort (if applicable, please provide other funding source information, amounts, and grant status). A thorough report including measurable outcomes and results will be expected at the end of the grant cycle along with a detailed breakdown of how the awarded funds were used. If you were awarded a grant in March 2024, an interim or final report is due in order for you to request funds for the upcoming cycle (2024 Interim or Final Report).
